Dr. George Gotsadze is the founder and President of the Curatio International Foundation (CIF), a not-for-profit Georgian research institution established in 1994 and working on health systems and policy issues in Eastern Europe and Central Asian Countries.

Dr. Gotsadze brings more than 25 years of experience, thorough knowledge, and expertise in health systems, health policy, and health financing issues. He has worked in over a dozen countries in Eastern Europe, Central Asia, Africa, the Caribbean, and the Middle East throughout this period. He has extensive experience working with the Global Fund, Gavi, the Vaccine Alliance, UNAIDS, The World Bank, WHO, UNICEF, and other organizations.

Dr. Gotsadze is an associate professor at the School of Public Health, Ilia State University, Georgia. Until 2014 he served as Vice-Chair of the Technical Review Panel of the Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis, and Malaria, and during 2018-2022 served as a member of Technical Evaluation Reference Group. Dr. Gotsadze has authored more than 80 publications, including peer-reviewed articles and book chapters. Dr. Gotsadze also served on numerous scientific panels of science funders and on the corporate boards of national and international not-for-profit organizations.
